## Receiving Credit Towards Institute Graduation or Transferring to a Church University

- 1. Attend 75% of classes (21/27)
- 2. Read Chapters 1-6 of Preach My Gospel.
- 3. Complete **One** of the following Elevate Learning Experiences (ELE):
  - Keep a study journal for the course. Take notes in class (digitally or in a paper journal)
  - Listen to a minimum of 6 episodes of the **Preach My Gospel Podcast**.
  - Write 3 essays. Pick any 3 topics you have learned from *Preach My Gospel* this semester. Write an essay describing what you learned and how you will use that knowledge in your own efforts to share the gospel.
  - Plan and complete a personal learning project. Your project should focus on the doctrine and principles from the course and provide evidence of your learning and application. (For example: You could memorize the Missionary Purpose Statement, The First Vision account, and the key doctrinal points of Lessons 1-3.)
  - Help another student successfully enroll in our class.

## **Attendance Makeup Options:**

- Listen to an episode of the <u>Preach My Gospel Podcast</u>. You can find the podcast on Spotify, Apple Podcasts, Google Podcasts, Anchor, Audible, YouTube, or Facebook. Each episode you listen to will make up one class period.
- Attend the weekly Institute Devotionals on Friday at Noon (in the North Chapel). Each one you attend will make up one class period.
- Watch a <u>Prospective Missionary Devotional</u> (*or*) <u>https://religion.byu.edu/missionarydevotional</u>. This will make up one class period. You can repeat this as many times as you need with previous devotionals.
- Spend 50 minutes studying *Preach My Gospel* and writing a 1-page essay on what you learned and how you might apply it in missionary work (or member missionary work). This will make up one class period. You can repeat this as many times as you need until your attendance reaches 75%.
