OVERVIEW

"Jesus Christ and His Everlasting Gospel" focuses on the eternal ministry of Jesus Christ and His divine roles throughout His premortal, mortal, and post-mortal life through the Scriptures, the Topical Guide, words of modern prophets, and "The Living Christ: The Testimony of the Apostles."

OBJECTIVES

- Increase your capacity to receive personal revelation;
- Enable you to testify of the divine roles Jesus Christ fulfills in the Father's plan;

- Critically read scripture;
- Search scriptures for connections, patterns, and themes;
- Share personal insights;
- Ask and answer sincere questions;
- Value and uplift each other as students of the Master.
